

Guidance for Students Discussion on academic integrity in an online examinations

Occasionally, students may be asked by the module convenor or marker to attend a discussion about how they went about completing an online exam. You might be asked by your module convenor, marker or another member of faculty to speak with them about this if a concern has been raised relating to academic integrity. This does not mean that there is a concern about your work.

It isn't a new assessment of your work and assessment that you submitted. You'll be asked to discuss your work with the marker.

No decisions on academic misconduct will be made by your module convenor, marker or other members of staff. The discussion is for the purposes of an investigation. The notes from the discussion will be sent to the Investigating Officer (see below).

What to expect in the discussion:

The discussion will usually take place over one or two sessions, arranged between the module convenor, marker and you.

What happens then?

The notes from the discussion will be provided
